Synopsis

Act 1: *On the eve of Prince Siegfried's coming-of-age party, villagers gather to ring in the celebration with him. As the villagers depart, the Queen arrives to give her son a new hunting crossbow as a birthday gift. Before departing, she reminds him that he has an obligation to pick a bride at the ball the following evening. As the sun is setting, with crossbow in hand, he sees a beautiful swan and follows her out of the palace grounds and to the Lake of Swans.*

Act 2: *Prince Siegfried watches from afar as the swans come out of the lake and transform into beautiful women. Odette, The Queen of the Swans, explains that they are all under the spell of the evil sorcerer, VonRothbart, doomed to be swans by day and women by night, unless the spell is broken by true love. Siegfried, captivated at once by Odette, pledges his faithful love to her and begs her to come to his ball the following evening so that he may select her as his bride.*

Act 3: *Guests arrive at the palace for the grand birthday celebration. The next to arrive is a princess from a foreign land. Finally, VonRothbart appears bringing in his own daughter, Odile, who has been transformed into Odette's double. Prince Siegfried dances with her and then proclaims her as his one true love. The plot is revealed and Siegfried, seeing the real Odette and realizing his mistake, immediately flees the ballroom.*

Together, with the power of love between Prince Siegfried and Odette, VonRothbart is defeated and true love conquers over evil.*

REMINDERS

- Please remember to respect social distancing guidelines. Families should sit at least 6 feet from surrounding families.
- If you choose to take photographs or video recordings during performances, we ask that you do so in a seated position as not to disrupt or block any other audience members. Children in the audience are NOT permitted to run around/play and must be with an adult and supervised at all times.
- Tents, canopies and umbrellas can only be used at the top of the hill so that all audience members are able to see the stage.
- Please remind your dancer to respect the personal space of others and clean up after him/herself at the conclusion of the performance. Parents will only be permitted backstage to help their dancer set up their space before the show and help them clean up their space after the show.
- In lieu of selling recital tickets, we are instead accepting donations to cover the costs to hold recitals and financially support the studio throughout the summer months. We hope each family can make a comfortable donation, keeping in mind that our recital tickets are typically \$15 per person. Donations can be sent to the studio or made at the recital via check, cash, or Venmo. *Card transactions will not be available.*
- Please stop by the table before the performance or during intermission to pick up your T-Shirt order!
